For five decades, this program has been at the heart of FFGC's youth outreach, offering immersive experiences that teach children grades 1-9 about conservation, wildlife, and ecology. Wekiva Youth Camp provides a unique opportunity for children to connect with nature, fostering a sense of responsibility and environmental awareness that will shape them into future conservationists.

Your registration fee of \$80 includes all meals for the weekend and housing accommodations. The first 36 registrants will be assigned to our air conditioned/heated volunteer cabins; remaining registrants will be housed in standard cabins.

Total cost for the weekend is \$80.00.
